Experts will speak on sources of and approaches for managing uncertainties and incorporating human behavior in anticipatory planning efforts.

In the series' fourth seminar, **Brett Milligan**, associate professor at UC Davis' Department of Human Ecology, will present on scenario development methods specific to the Delta region. 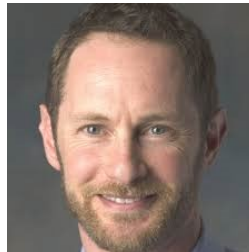
