## DELTA INDEPENDENT SCIENCE BOARD NAMES DR. INGE WERNER CHAIR-ELECT

SACRAMENTO – At its March 27, 2023, meeting, the Delta Independent Science Board voted Dr. Inge Werner from its existing membership as chair-elect. Dr. Werner's chair-elect duties began immediately. She will assume chair duties in September 2024.

Prior to joining the Delta ISB in November 2022, Dr. Werner was director of the Swiss Centre for Applied Ecotoxicology for nine years. In Switzerland, she worked closely with federal and local environmental agencies to improve monitoring programs and cooperated in research projects with academic institutions throughout Europe and the United States. Projects included assessments of advanced wastewater treatment technologies and environmental risks due to pesticides.

"Dr. Werner's commitment to translating scientific knowledge into real-world application, and her ability to communicate with stakeholders, make her ideal for leading the Delta ISB," says Board Chair Dr. Lisa Wainger. "With a background in both academic research and supporting the design of regulatory measures, her expertise in bridging the gap between these two worlds will be invaluable to the role of chair."

Throughout her career, Dr. Werner has served on numerous panels and working groups. Most recently, this has included the Scientific Advisory Council of the German Federal Institute of Hydrology, which is the primary German institution advising the federal ministries in matters of utilization and management of waterways, and the Guidance Committee for the Assessment of Surface Water Resources in Switzerland, which advises decision-makers in all aspects of surface water stewardship.

"It is an honor to serve as chair-elect of the Delta ISB," says Dr. Werner. "I look forward to working with the Board to oversee the research, monitoring, and

Dr. Werner holds a Ph.D. in aquatic ecotoxicology from Johannes-Gutenberg University Mainz and a Master of Science in limnology from Albert-Ludwig Freiburg University, both in Germany.
