

## 2022-2026 Science Action Agenda: Delta Management Questions Workshop

## **Event Details:**

The first step in the 2022-2026 Science Action Agenda (SAA) update process is to identify major management questions for the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta. Over 1,200 management questions were submitted to the Delta Stewardship Council's (Council) Delta Science Program (DSP) in spring-summer 2020 for the effort.

This virtual workshop hosted via Microsoft Teams will include nine concurrent breakout sessions to collaboratively refine a top list of Delta management questions.

Breakout session attendees will discuss, edit, and prioritize relevant management questions within the following nine themes: Delta as an Evolving Place, Flood Risk and Land Use Management, Habitat Management, Invasive Species/Non-native Species Management, Native Species Management I (Management and Interactions), Native Species Management II (Population Tracking), Science Governance, Water Quality Management, and Water Supply Management.
