

State and Federal Agencies Hold Second Meeting on Implementing Delta Plan

SACRAMENTO –The Delta Plan Interagency Implementation Committee (DPIIC) will hold its second meeting on Monday, November 17. The heads of more than a dozen state and federal agencies will discuss implementation progress of the Delta Plan and the California Water Action Plan in relation to federal investments for the Bay-Delta region. The Committee will review progress on priorities identified at its inaugural meeting in April. These include development of an updated strategy to guide state investments in Delta levees, development of the Interim Science Action Agenda in support of the *One Delta, One Science* concept, coordination around habitat restoration, and identifying opportunities to integrate and leverage funding for these efforts and others.

The Committee is a requirement of the 2009 Delta Reform Act, which also created the Delta Stewardship Council, called for in the Delta Plan, and declared as State policy the coequal goals of a more reliable water supply for California and protecting, restoring, and enhancing the Delta ecosystem.

The meeting is open to the public and will be webcast.
