Can Coequal = Multifunctional?

The coequal goals for the Delta emphasize the need to plan and design restored landscapes that can perform a variety of desired functions for human and non-human users. Large-scale habitat restoration will require significant changes in current land uses, cultural patterns, and forms of economic productivity. These actions pose challenges and opportunities for human use of restored and naturalized lands.

Within these emerging landscapes, how might human presence and activity, such as recreation and other purposes, be accommodated and beneficially contribute to Delta recovery efforts? This presentation will introduce conceptual design proposals for specific Delta landscapes and infrastructures that may begin to address challenges and needs in the Delta.
