 7. Delta Plan Contract Amendment (**Action Item**)

Staff will seek the approval of a contract amendment for the CH2MHill contract. Staff is seeking to add \$800,000 through fiscal year 2015-2016 to fund tasks related to Performance Management and Delta Plan implementation.

"Coequal goals" means the two goals of providing a more reliable water supply for California and protecting, restoring, and enhancing the Delta ecosystem. The coequal goals shall be achieved in a manner that protects and enhances the unique cultural, recreational, natural resource, and agricultural values of the Delta as an evolving place."

8. Delta Levee Investment Strategy Update (Information Item)

Staff will present the Council with draft recommendations regarding State interests that Delta levee investments should further. A panel of State agency representatives will discuss these State interests with the Council. Staff will also provide an overall update on this project, focusing on efforts related to public outreach, the independent peer review panel and technical tasks.


