PURPOSE

On November 17, 2014, the Delta Plan Interagency Implementation Committee (DPIIC) directed member agency staff to collectively identify a short list of multi-agency, multi-benefit science actions that support decision-relevant science and could be implemented in 2015-16. As requested, member agency staff used the Interim Science Action Agenda as a foundation and drafted the list of proposed high-priority science actions to present to the DPIIC on May 11, 2015.

This public briefing is intended to introduce stakeholders and the broader Delta community to the outcomes of this exercise and to share the draft list for public comment.
