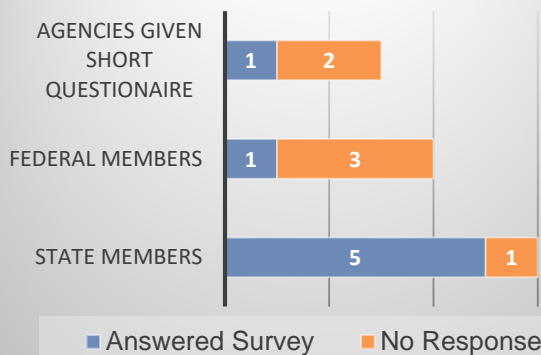




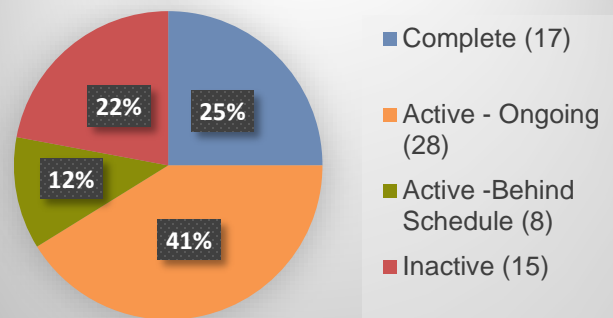
## Delta Plan Administrative Performance Measures Survey Results

The Delta Stewardship Council sent voluntary surveys to Delta Plan Interagency Implementation Committee (DPIIC) agencies in early 2018 requesting updates on existing administrative performance measures where the agency is the lead or co-lead. Six of the ten DPIIC agencies responded to the survey: The Delta Protection Commission, the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Conservancy, the California Department of Fish and Wildlife, the California Department of Water Resources, the State Water Resources Control Board, and the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation. In total, DPIIC agencies provided feedback on 68 of the 121 administrative measures. In addition, three DPIIC agencies without a Delta Plan performance measure received a simplified questionnaire. One agency responded to the short questionnaire; the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

### Administrative Performance Measures: Priorities for the Responding DPIIC Agencies<sup>φ</sup>

- Local governments prepare plans for each Delta community
- Encourage partnerships between agencies, landowners, and businesses
- Adopt criteria for prioritizing large scale Delta eco restoration\*
- Investigate the opportunity for carbon market for Delta farmers\*
- Implementers identify projects and funding for habitat restoration
- Identify groundwater basins in critical condition with groundwater plans\*
- Encourage habitat enhancement and wildlife-friendly farming systems\*
- Avoid or mitigate invasive species for proposed improved habitat\*
- Adopt Delta flow objectives necessary by June 2018\*
- Establish advisory group to meet water conservation goals\*
- Report to Council - actions to address critical groundwater basins\*
- Adopt policy on evaluation of water rights that increase Delta water use\*
- Evaluate appropriate protections in applicable water quality plans
- Adopt objectives for nutrients in Delta
- Complete Total Maximum Daily Loads and Basin Plan Amendments for mercury\*
- Require additional information on water efficiency, water supply projects, and net consumptive use\*

<sup>φ</sup> Priority Administrative Performance Measures were identified by the responsible agency in the survey by marking the measure as a high priority (rank 5 out of a scale 1-5) for the next five years.

\* Performance Measures that the responsible agency marked in the survey as needing to be updated (rank 5 out of a scale 1-5) and ranked as a high priority.

## The Administrative Performance Measures Dashboard

The Delta Plan Administrative performance measures survey responses will be used to update the online Dashboard, a public-facing reporting tool the Council maintains to communicate the status of key administrative actions in the Delta.

The Council is initiating a five-year review of the 2013 Delta Plan. The survey provides DPIIC agencies an opportunity to share up-to-date information with the Council on their actions that affect the Delta.

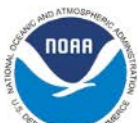
