

## State and Federal Agencies Hold Inaugural Meeting to Implement Delta Plan

SACRAMENTO –The Delta Plan Interagency Implementation Committee (DPIIC) will hold its inaugural meeting on Wednesday April 9. The heads of more than a dozen state and federal agencies will discuss common points and priorities of the Delta Plan, the California Water Action Plan and the Federal Investments for the Bay-Delta Region. The Committee also will discuss progress on current implementation projects and how a common need for best available science binds all agencies and their work to achieve Delta health and sustainability.

The Committee is a requirement of the 2009 Delta Reform Act, which created the Delta Stewardship Council, called for the Delta Plan, and declared the coequal goals of a more reliable water supply for California and protecting, restoring, and enhancing the Delta ecosystem as state policy for the Delta.
