

# Delta Plan Policies & Recommendations

## RR R1. Implement Emergency Preparedness and Response

Implement the recommendations of the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Multi- Hazard Coordination Task Force.


DWR should expand its emergency stockpiles to make them regional in nature and usable by a large number of agencies and consider creating stored material sites by “over-reinforcing” west Delta levees .

Local levee-maintaining agencies should consider developing their own emergency action plans, and stockpiling rock and flood fighting materials.

Agencies should prepare coordinated emergency response plans to protect the infrastructure from long-term outages resulting from failures of the Delta levees.


