

Errata: Staff-suggested technical, non-substantial changes to the modified regulatory text

§ 5001. Definitions.

- (u) "Government-sponsored flood control program to reduce risks to people, property, and State
- (y) "Proposed action" means a plan, program, or project that meets the covered action screening criteria listed in Section 5001(j)(1)(A) through ~~(D)(E)~~.
- (dd)(3) Temporary water transfers ... upon the Department of Water Resources' and the State Water Resources Control Board's participation with stakeholders to identify and implement transfer measures, as recommended in the Delta Plan's Water Resources Recommendation Number 15 (WRR ~~R~~15);
- (dd)(4) Other projects exempt from CEQA, unless there are unusual circumstances indicating a reasonable possibility that the project will have a significant impact under Water Code Section 85057.5(a)(4), as further defined by this ~~Section 5001(dd) of this Chapter~~.
- (dd)(4)(B) Small-scale habitat restoration projects, as referred to in CEQA Guidelines, ~~section 15333 of Title 14 of the California Administrative Code 15333~~, proposed in important restoration areas, but which are inconsistent with the Delta Plan's policy related to appropriate habitat restoration for a given land elevation (Section 5006 of this Chapter).

§ 5003. Reduce Reliance on the Delta through Improved Regional Water Self-Reliance.

- (c)(1)(B) Identified, evaluated and commenced implementation, consistent with the implementation schedule set forth in the ~~management~~ Plan, of all programs and projects included in the Plan that are locally cost effective and technically feasible which reduce reliance on the Delta; and,
