It did not collapse as expected. Also, apparently probes in the peat soils showed little disturbance. Do you know if his studies are complete, and will you use this information? I have not heard anything further and wonder if these findings will be used by the DSC. The dire predictions for levee collapse in the event of an earthquake are much touted by the BDCP. Thank you.
