The upcoming Council meeting will be held at the West Sacramento City Hall Galleria, 1110 West Capitol Avenue, West Sacramento, CA 95691. The agenda and supporting materials are attached. Some additional handouts may be provided at the meeting.

This two-day meeting will focus on collaborative approaches to implementing the Delta Plan. Among these are: considering approval of DWR's Flood Emergency Facilities Improvement Project which prepositions flood response material for use by DWR and Delta reclamation districts; discussing impediments to near-term projects to learn about commonly encountered barriers to progress; and discussing the Science Program's role in the progress of the Collaborative Science and Adaptive Management Process being undertaken to inform implementation of the Biological Opinions.
