The Final Draft Delta Conservation Plan and Recirculated PEIR Volume 3 have a concurrent due dates for public review yet you proceed with regulatory actions.

“Drafts” are referred to in this document, yet no plans have been approved. This could mean any form of the drafts.

“Best Available Science” is a judgment term. Best Available Science to the area in question, or the general subject matter.

“Adaptive Management” is based on generalities or a designated database with facts and scenarios.

Will monitoring be open and available on a publically accessed website?

Is habitat restoration based on historical models, or migratory models? How are weather patterns including extreme weather patterns applied? Is the State viewed entirely, or just this region.

How do these regulations affect other regions dependent on the Delta?
