I am a Californian concerned about both my water and our state's environment, and the fish and wildlife that need it for survival. I am concerned about the Bay-Delta because it is a rich and diverse watershed, and home to one of our state's iconic fish - Chinook salmon. We need to recover this estuary and these fish before they go extinct.

I know the Environmental Water Caucus, representing 30 state-wide groups, presented recommendations to the Council in Stockton for the EIR and Delta Plan. I want you to know I support their recommendations, and ask the Council to evaluate these recommendations as alternatives in the development of this plan. It is critical that the Council realize that new and innovative strategies on water management are needed to balance both the state's water needs and the recovery of the Delta.

These recommendations can serve as a framework for this new approach to water management.
