I support the goals of the Delta Plan. Implementation of the "Peripheral Canal" is completely contrary to the Delta Plan, ignoring 75-90% of the coequal goals. Allowing the Peripheral Canal does not, at all, "restore the Delta Ecosystem" and fails to "provide a more reliable water system for California," except for a very limited number of Central Valley farmers. The Peripheral Canal is not consistent with "Covered Actions," as required by the Delta Plan. It will 1) ruin the Delta Ecosystem and 2) make the water supply no more reliable. The Delta is the primary 'nursery' for the Pacific Coast and crucial to the Pacific Ocean, and beyond. Adoption or allowing of the Peripheral Canal is 1) malfeasance on a grand scale, 2) will lead to catastrophic consequences to the entire ecosystem, and 3) reduce water quality.
