Summary: Dr. Sam Luoma, Editor-in-Chief of the Council's peer-reviewed online journal *San Francisco Estuary and Watershed Science*, will brief the Council on the contributions nine experts made in their recently published essays on the joint statement of Governor Brown and Interior Secretary Ken Salazar: "Science will guide how to best restore the ecosystem and how much water can be exported" (Natural Resources Agency 2012)."
