

Update from the State Water Resources Control Board's Delta Watermaster

Summary: Craig M. Wilson, Delta Watermaster will provide a brief informational update report on Monitoring and Compliance.

Background

The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), as the State's principal water resources regulatory agency, has existing statutory authority to help implement and enforce many types of regulatory policies and recommendations that will likely be included in the Delta Plan. California Water Code Section 85320 (d) directs the State's Delta Watermaster to submit regular reports to the State Water Board and to the Council on water issues. The Delta Watermaster, Craig Wilson, has recently drafted a report that was presented to the State Water Board on September 19, 2012 entitled: *Improving Water Right Enforcement Authority*. The report focuses on the State Water Board's authority to enforce and monitor water rights and to prevent unauthorized diversions of water in the state of California.

Mr. Wilson will brief the Council on this report and engage in a discussion with Council members.
