In response to the Final Draft Delta Plan I have the following concerns.

We need protection for boating and recreation on the Delta. The plan must follow the requirements of the Recreational Boaters o California, allowing for boaters to be able to navigate to and from their homes without requiring them to use alternative routes without expending extra fuel and limiting additional pollution caused by these obstructions.

The water exportation to the Westlands farmers should be evaluated, by the crops that are being grown, for which this water is needed. If less water thirsty crops would be farmed in that area, the Delta waters would not need to be sent south. This is another water grab attempt. Westlands farms require over 8 times as much water per acre to irrigate than our Delta farms. Keep our Delta farms producing the fine local crops our area is noted for.

Stop the water grab, leave the Delta alone.
