Re: Request to Include Alternate Delta Plan as a Project Alternative in the EIR

Dear Chairman Isenberg and Members of the Council:

A coalition of agencies and organizations representing the interests of water agencies, businesses, and farms from throughout the state submitted an Alternate Delta Plan to the Council on June 10, 2011, and requested that the Council include the Alternate Delta Plan as a project alternative in the draft environmental impact report for the Delta Plan.

As a member of the Vallecitos Water District Board of Director, I have had a chance to review the Alternate Delta Plan and fully support its inclusion as a project alternative in the draft EIR. The Alternate Delta Plan lays out a truly comprehensive approach to achieving the co-equal goals that we believe warrants full discussion by the Council.

The Alternate Delta Plan, as a project alternative in the draft EIR, will assure that the Council has a complete range of options to consider as the final Delta Plan is formulated by the Jan. 1, 2012, deadline.

Accordingly, this is a request that Council include the Alternate Delta Plan in its entirety as a project alternative in the draft EIR for the Delta Plan.

Vallecitos Water District, as a member of Association of California Water Districts, remains committed to working with the ACWA and the Delta Stewardship Council as a partner in developing a plan that can further the achievement of the co-equal goals of ecosystem restoration and water supply reliability.
