

## Yolo County: Westside Yolo Bypass Management Option (Log number Nov11 - 6)

---

**Staff Recommendation:** No action at this time.

The Delta Stewardship Council does not have the financial resources to develop this concept.

---

### **Background**

The applicant is requesting the Delta Stewardship Council (Council) to support and assist with efforts to conduct further conceptual studies, surveying, and modeling for the Westside Option as an alternative means of achieving floodplain habitat restoration objectives of the “Fremont Weir Conservation Measure” as a component of the developing Bay Delta Conservation Plan (BDCP).

This is a concept at the early stages of investigation. A proposal resulting from additional conceptual studies and modeling should undergo scientific review before being considered for implementation. This concept is proposed as an alternative to modification of the Fremont Weir but all or parts of it could be integrated with other approaches for improving the flood plain functions of the Yolo bypass to benefit species of concern.

The Council may support and encourage the development of studies and projects that are consistent with the eight objectives inherent to the coequal goals, however the Council does not have the resources to provide any assistance for this early action request.
