Thank you for the opportunity to submit comments on the Interim Delta Plan. The Yolo Basin Foundation has over 20 years of experience working successfully with Yolo Bypass stakeholders. At this time there are two well-established stakeholder groups that would welcome working with the Delta Stewardship Council (DSC): The Yolo Bypass Working Group and the Lower Yolo Bypass Planning Forum. These two groups have created multiple documents that can be of great assistance to the DSC staff and board members as development of the Delta Plan progresses. The Yolo Bypass Wildlife Area Land Management Plan, listed in Appendix V of the Interim Plan is an exemplary document for managing the largest wetland restoration program in the Delta. This plan was developed from the ground up with extensive stakeholder discussion at every step.
