The proposed regulations would implement policies established by the Council in the 2022 Ecosystem Amendment to Chapter 4 of the Delta Plan, as previously adopted pursuant to the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Reform Act of 2009 (Wat. Code, § 85000 et seq.) and the California Environmental Quality Act. (Pub. Resources Code, § 21000)
