Administrative Procedure Act Rulemaking Process

On September 21, 2023, the Office of Administrative Law approved the Delta Levees Investment Strategy rulemaking action pursuant to section 11349.3 of the Government Code. The <u>updated regulations</u> became effective on January 1, 2024.
