1. Welcome and Introductions

2. Potential DPIIC Action on the 2026 Delta Science Plan: Strengthening Science in the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta (Action Item)

The Delta Science Plan, called for in the Delta Plan, is a key framework for conducting, coordinating, and communicating science in the Delta. It emphasizes collaborations and relationships that transform shared knowledge into collective action. Staff from the Council will present the 2026 Science Plan update to the DPIIC, and the DPIIC will deliberate on potential action.

3. Interweaving Traditional Knowledge with Delta Science: Report on the 2026 Roundtable Series and Examples from DPIIC Member Agencies (Information Item)

Representatives from the Council and Shingle Springs Band of Miwok Indians will provide an update on the recent Roundtable series, which supported interweaving of traditional knowledge with science-based adaptive management and decision-

making. They will be joined by representatives from the Department of Water Resources, California State University, Chico, and the State Water Resources Control Board to provide examples of interweaving efforts underway within DPIIC member agencies.

4. Overview of the Delta Adapts Adaptation Plan and Initial Implementation (Information Item)

In June 2025, the Council adopted the Delta Adapts [Adaptation Plan](https://deltacouncil.ca.gov/pdf/delta-plan/2025-06-26-delta-adapts-adaptation-plan.pdf) (<https://deltacouncil.ca.gov/pdf/delta-plan/2025-06-26-delta-adapts-adaptation-plan.pdf>), which outlines regional vulnerabilities to environmental hazards and proposes adaptation strategies. Council staff and the California Sea Grant social science extension specialist will provide an overview of the Adaptation Plan and initial efforts underway to implement the plan, including the creation of a Delta Climate Adaptation Team to support regional collaboration.

5. Closing Remarks (Information Item)

The DPIIC members will have the opportunity to share closing comments and propose topics for upcoming meetings.
