Purpose

The Delta ISB will meet to discuss its reviews and activities, including its review on subsidence, food-webs, and decision-making under deep uncertainty. In addition, Sam Pyros, California Sea Grant Fellow, and Dr. Steve Culberson, Interagency Ecological Program Lead Scientist, will present a comprehensive review of California Sacramento-San Joaquin green and white sturgeon population characteristics.

The California Department of Water Resources is currently on track to issue a Final Environmental Impact Report for the proposed Delta Conveyance Project in late 2023. The Delta ISB will prepare for its upcoming review of the final Environmental Impact Report.

4. Discussion: Sacramento/Delta Update to the Bay-Delta Water Quality Control Plan

The State Water Resources Control Board is currently considering updates to the Bay-Delta Water Quality Control Plan focused on the Sacramento River and its tributaries, Delta eastside tributaries (including the Calaveras, Cosumnes, and Mokelumne Rivers), interior Delta flows, and Delta outflows, including consideration of proposed voluntary agreements. On September 28, 2023, the State Water Resources Control Board released a [draft Staff Report](#) in support of Sacramento/Delta updates to the Bay-Delta Water Quality Control Plan for public review and comment. The Delta ISB will discuss the draft Staff Report and any next steps.

6. Presentation: A Collaboratory to Support Decision-Making for Adaptive Stewardship of the Sacramento-San Joaquin River System by Dr. Laurel Larsen

"A Collaboratory to Support Decision-Making for Adaptive Stewardship of the Sacramento-San Joaquin River System" is a strategy document to advance an integrated modeling framework for the Delta. It compiles findings from the Integrated Modeling Workshop held in 2023 and a set of four memos previously issued by the Delta Science Program that describe the technical components of a modeling collaboratory. The strategy emphasizes the importance of research-agency-community partnerships and suggests next steps to cultivate leadership and develop a funding and governance structure. Feedback on elements of the strategy will be sought from ISB members.

7. Presentation: California Sacramento-San Joaquin Green and White Sturgeon: A Comprehensive Review

Sam Pyros, California Sea Grant Fellow, and Dr. Steve Culberson, Interagency Ecological Program Lead Scientist, will present a comprehensive review of California Sacramento-San Joaquin green and white sturgeon. This review addresses sturgeon population characteristics specifically, and more generally outlines continuing data needs to improve management efforts and outcomes. It is a deliverable from a 2023 Sea Grant State Fellowship.

8. Discussion: Decision-making Under Deep Uncertainty Review

The Delta ISB will discuss progress made on its decision-making under deep uncertainty review ([see prospectus](#)). The review will build an understanding of the scientific tools and concepts that can increase the capacity to anticipate and adapt to growing uncertainty of future conditions in the Bay-Delta system.

9. Discussion: Subsidence Review

The Delta ISB will discuss progress made on its subsidence review ([see prospectus](#)). This review will synthesize and evaluate the state of science related to subsidence management in order to provide recommendations to inform and guide ongoing and future subsidence management.

10. Discussion: Food-webs Review

The Delta ISB will discuss progress made on its food-webs review ([see prospectus](#)). The review will assess the importance of food-web interactions in the Delta, and identify where improved understanding and tools (e.g., food-web models) might substantially improve predictions of an individual species' response to environmental drivers and management actions.
