3. Presentation and Discussion: Delta Science Plan

Over the past few years, the Delta Science Program has been working to update the <u>2019 Delta Science Plan</u>, a shared framework that provides vision, principles, and approaches for conducting and coordinating science in the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta and more effectively communicating the outcomes of science activities and their management implications to policymakers. The Delta Science Program staff will present the updated draft Delta Science Plan and its request to the Delta ISB to conduct a formal review of the Delta Science Plan.

4. Delta Lead Scientist Report

The Delta Science Program will provide an update on the latest research and scientific activities in the region, including the 2025 State of Our Estuary, 2025 State of Bay-Delta Science and the work of an *ad hoc* committee of the National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine that has finished a review of the monitoring, modeling, and other relevant scientific activities and initiatives that support the long-term operations of the Central Valley Project.

5. <u>Discussion:</u> Subsidence Review

The Delta ISB is seeking input from the public on its draft review, "Science to Inform Management of Subsided Lands in the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta." This report summarizes key findings and recommendations developed by the Delta ISB on the science needed for improving the management of subsided lands in the Delta. Comments are due by December 1, 2025, via email to disb@deltacouncil.ca.gov. The Delta ISB will discuss any public comments received to date.

6. <u>Discussion:</u> Next Steps on Products from the Emerging Climate Science Symposium

The Delta ISB hosted a hybrid symposium as part of its public meeting from September 16-17, 2025, at UC Davis that brought together over 250 scientists, practitioners, and decision-makers to assess the latest climate science and its implications for the Sacramento–San Joaquin Delta. The Delta ISB will discuss products coming out of the symposium and recent presentations highlighting key takeaways from the symposium.
