The Delta ISB will meet virtually to discuss its reviews on nature-based solutions and subsidence. In addition, the Delta ISB will consider and potentially elect its next chair-elect, whose term would begin on September 1, 2026. During this meeting, Dr. Inge Werner will reflect on her term as chair, ahead of becoming the past-chair on September 1, 2026. Current Chair-elect Dr. Diane McKnight will assume the position of chair on the same date.

1. Welcome and Declarations
2. Election of New Delta ISB Chair-Elect (**Action Item**)

On September 1, 2026, Chair-elect Dr. Diane McKnight will become chair, and

Chair Dr. Inge Werner will become past chair. The Delta ISB will discuss the election of a new chair-elect and may take action to elect a new chair-elect from its existing membership to start chair-elect duties on September 1, 2026.

3. Discussion: Nature-based Solutions Review (**Action Item**)

The Delta ISB is in the process of scoping a review on nature-based solutions and will discuss a draft prospectus. To help inform this review, the Delta ISB will host a series of panels at its meetings over the coming months to explore nature-based solutions, including the associated challenges and needs to help shape a potential review by the Delta ISB that is meaningful and useful for the Delta community. The [first panel](#) took place at the May 2026 ISB meeting, featuring perspectives from State agencies to understand what is occurring in California. Based on the discussion, the Delta ISB may take action on next steps.

4. Discussion: Subsidence Review (**Action Item**)

The Delta ISB will discuss revisions to address public comments on its draft report on the subsidence review. The report summarizes key findings and recommendations developed by the Delta ISB on the science needed for improving the management of subsided lands in the Delta. Based on the discussion, the Delta ISB may take action on next steps.

5. Presentation: Current Delta ISB Chair's Reflections on Term as Chair

This will be the last meeting where Dr. Inge Werner will preside as chair. On September 1, 2026, she will become past-chair. Dr. Werner will reflect on her term as chair.

6. Public Comment

The Delta ISB will take public comment on topics within its jurisdiction that are not on the agenda.

7. Preparation for Upcoming Meetings and Review of Items for Follow-up

Staff will provide an overview of upcoming meetings and a summary of any follow-up items for individual members to address after the meeting.
